(that is to say) First All my Household Goods and Furniture Linen Plate
China Ready Money Securities for Money Book Debts and all other my
Personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever Subject to the Payment of my Funeral
Expences and Debts I Give and bequeath Unto my Sons in Law Henry Branson and
George Gee of Great Wigston in the said County of Leicester Executors their Executors
Administrators or Assigns Upon Trust that they the said Henry Branson
and George Gee, or the Survivor of them or the Executors Administrators or Assigns
of such Survivor do and shall immediately after my Decease Convert such part of
my Personal Estate into Money as shall not consist of Money at such my Decease
and call in all such Sum or Sums of Money that shall be due and owing to me
and out of such Money so raised by Sale of my said Personal Estate and Money so due
and owing to me together with my Ready Money In the first place pay my Funeral
Expences and Debts and such Expences they may be put unto in the Execution of this
my Will and the Trust hereby in him and them reposed And in the next place pay
and Dispose of the residue of my said Personal Estate in manner following that is
to say to pay One fifth Part thereof Unto my Daughter Mary Branson her Executors
or Administrators One other fifth Part thereof Unto my Daughter Sarah Gee her
Executors or Administrators One other fifth Part thereof Unto my Daughter Elizabeth
Lewis her Executors or Administrators One other fifth Part thereof Unto my Daughter
Hannah Goddard her Executors or Administrators And the remaining Fifth Part thereof
Unto my Grandchildren Sarah Ann, Hannah, William, Charlotte and John Heap (being
Daughters and Sons of my late Daughter Ann Heap deceased) equally Share and Share
alike when and as they respectively attain their respective Ages of Twenty one years
But in Case any of my said Grandchildren shall depart this Life before they attain
the Age of Twenty one years then to pay the Share of her, him or them so dying
Unto and amongst the Survivor of them Share and Share alike when and as they receive
their Original Share if more than one shall live to attain the said Age if only one then
to such one wholly her or his Executors Administrators or Assigns But in Case I
