

This is the last Will and Testament

of me Joseph Pywell of Great Glenn in the county of Leicestershire
frameworkknitter as follows, videlicet, I give and bequeath

to my sister Ann Ellingworth of Great Glenn aforesaid widow
the Bed bedstead and the furniture belonging to the same which
I now sleep in. I give and bequeath to Ann Wells

wife of William Wells of Great Glenn aforesaid the sum of
Twenty pounds for her own use and benefit. I give to

Robert Kirby Ten pounds and to William Kirby and Ann
Store wife of William Store of Great Glenn aforesaid

frameworkknitter sons and daughter of Robert Kirby of the
same place frameworkknitter Five pounds each for their own
use and benefit which legacies I direct to be paid by my

Executors hereinafter named within six calendar months next
after my decease. I give and bequeath to my

nephews Thomas Pywell son of my brother Thomas Pywell

and Thomas Pywell son of my brother David Pywell now
soldiers in his Majesty's service Five pounds each to be paid
to them when they return home. And I give and

bequeath all my household goods and furniture and all other
my personal estate and effects whatsoever (after payment and

discharge of all my debts and funeral expenses and the above
mentioned legacies) unto the said Ann Ellingworth for the

term of her natural life And after her decease I give and
devise the same unto her four children James, Joseph and

Ann Ellingworth and Elizabeth the wife of Robert Falkner
equally to be divided between them share and share alike

I also give and devise all that my mesuage or tenement

wherein I now dwell with the orchard and other appurtenances
thereunto belonging And all other my real Estate whatsoever
(Subject to the payment of the legacies hereinbefore by me
bequeathed and which I charge upon my real Estate
accordingly) unto my said sister Ann Ellingworth and
her assigns during the term of her natural life without
impeachment of waste and after her decease I give and
devise the same unto her said four children James,
Joseph and Ann Ellingworth and Elizabeth the wife of
Robert Falkner and to their respective heirs and assigns
for ever as tenants in common and not as joint tenants
And I constitute and appoint my said sister Ann
Ellingworth sole executrix of this my will In
Witness whereof I the said Joseph Piroell the testator
have hereunto set my hand and seal the first day of
October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and ten. /
